Academic Assessment Report: 2019-20

The Academic Audit Committee met at 3.30 PM on 12.11.2020 to review the performance of Final Year students of under graduate and post graduate classes, passing their respective degree examination in 2020.

The finding of the committee is recorded below.

Under Graduate classes

- Out of 691 UG students, 515 students passed.
- Overall, 74.52% students of the UG classes passed their examination.
- No department attained 100% result this year.
- This year, there are only 0 subjects in which 90% or more students have passed. These subjects are Education (96.2%), English (92.31%), and Sanskrit (92.31%).
- More than 80% students from the following hons. subjects passed the examination. These are Odia (87.5%), Pol Sc. (86.49%), Botany (87.72%), Chemistry (82%), Physics (86.5%), Mathematics Sc. (81.08%) and Zoology (88.24%).
- More than 70% students from the following hons. subjects passed the examination. These are Geography (75%), History (72.22%), Sociology (78.57%) and Comp. Science (78.43%).
- Less than 60% students of the following four departments passed the examination this year. Mathematics Arts (42.86%), Economics (53.06%), Philosophy (57.14%), and Commerce (53.29%).
- 92 students of different departments joined PG/MBA/BED courses this year.

Post Graduate classes.

- All students of the Departments of Physics (15/15), Pol. Sc. (26/26) and Zoology (09/09) passed the examination.
- More than 90% students of Department of Odia (96%) passed the examination.
- 76.92% students of the Department of Economics passed the examination.

Department of Professional Studies.

- *15out of 15 students passed their BBA examination (100%).
- * 26 out of the 29 students passed their MCOM examination. (89.66%)
- * 16 out of 17 students passed their IMBA examination. (94.12%)

* 32 out of 32 students passed their MBA examination. (100%)

Observation of the committee

- * Overall pass percentage was not satisfactory.
- * HODs of the departments where less than 80% students have passed will be requested to take all possible measures to increase the pass percentage.
- * The committee congratulates the toppers of various departments.
- * Due to Covid-19 pandemic, the college had to be closed down for a long period. Besides, classes were taken on-line. There was also a certain degree of uncertainty as to whether the examination will be conducted on-line or off-line. All this confusion might have led to the poor performance of students in the examination.
 - * Like the previous year, this time 92 students have qualified to join PG/MBA/BED programmes conducted by different institutes.
 - * HODs of the departments where less than 60% of the students have passed are requested to take greater care of the students for improvement in performance.
- * 785 students received scholarships from the Government. The scholarship amount was directly transferred into the accounts of the beneficiaries.
