Academic Assessment Report: 2020-21

The Academic Audit Committee met at 3.00 PM on 12.10.2021 to review the performance of Final Year students of under graduate and post graduate classes, passing their respective degree examination in 2021.

The finding of the committee is recorded below.

Under Graduate classes

- Out of 659 UG students, 599 students passed.
- Overall, 90.89% students of the UG classes passed their examination.
- One department attained 100% result this year, i.e, the Department of Physics.
- This year, there are 08 subjects in which 90% or more students have passed. These subjects are Education (92.31%), Sanskrit (93.75%), Sociology (96.15%), Botany (93.48%), Chemistry (93.48%), Computer Science (90.38%), Science Mathematics (96.43%), and Commerce (91.28%).
- More than 80% students from each of the following hon. subjects passed the examination. Mathematics Arts (80%), Economics (81.82%), Geography (88.89%), History (86.11%), Odia (89.29%), Philosophy (84.62%), Pol. Sc. (88.64%), and Zool (89.13%).
- More than 70% students with English hon. (72.73%) passed the examination.
- 83 students of different departments joined PG/MBA/BED courses this year.

Post Graduate classes.

- 93.33% students from the Department of Physics, 92.31% students from the Department of Zoology, 92.31% students from the Department of Economics, 92.86% students from the Department of Odia, and 96.67% students from the Department of Political Science passed the PG examinations in their respective subjects.
- 93 out of 99 students passed the PG Examination in different subjects (93.93%).

Department of Professional Studies.

- *02 out of 05 students passed their BBA examination (40%).
- *08 out of the 10 students passed their MCOM examination. (80%)
- * 05 out of 07 students passed their IMBA examination. (71.43%)

* 26 out of 44 students passed their MBA examination. (59.09%)

Observation of the committee

- * Overall pass percentage was satisfactory.
- * HODs of the departments where less than 80% students have passed will be requested to take all possible measures to increase the pass percentage.
- * The committee congratulates the toppers of various departments.
- * Students of the Department of Professional Studies have not fared well in the examination. The HOD of the department is advised to implement corrective measures so that such poor performance of the students is not repeated in future.
- * Like the previous year, this time 83 students have qualified to join PG/MBA/BED programmes conducted by different institutes.
- * Courses in all subjects were completed in time.
- * 674 students received scholarships from the Government. The scholarship amount was directly transferred into the accounts of the beneficiaries.
